Foreign students will be admitted to the Graduate School of Business Administration at Sakarya University in the Fall Semester of the 2021-2022 Academic Year to meet the requirements approved by the Head of the Institute Department.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR MASTER DEGREE PROGRAMMES

> Applicants should meet the requirements approved by the Head of the Institute Department.

The Minimum Assessment Requirements for Foreign Students:

Foreign Student Applicants (required to hold an undergraduate degree diploma with a GPA of “at least 2.5 out of 4”) can apply to the Sakarya University International Student Office. The assessment will be made based on the GPAs of the applicants achieved from their undergraduate educations with no undertaking additional exams depending on the placements mentioned below.

* One or two semesters of scientific preparation programme can be asked for the students who received an undergraduate education with a different curriculum if the head of the relevant department requests.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR PHD DEGREE PROGRAMMES

> Applicants should meet the requirements approved by the Head of the Institute Department.

The Minimum Assessment Requirements for Foreign Students:

Foreign Student Applicants (required to hold a master’s degree diploma with a GPA of “at least 2.5 out of 4”) can apply to the Sakarya University International Student Office. The assessment will be made based on the GPAs of the applicants achieved from their master’s degree educations with no undertaking additional exams depending on the placements mentioned below.

** One or two semesters of scientific preparation programme can be asked for the students who received a master’s degree education with a different curriculum if the head of the relevant department requests.

The Documents Required for Registrations

1. Diploma or graduation certificates (translated in Turkish)
2. Transcript (translated in Turkish)
3. Passport with education valid entry visa
4. Turkish Proficiency Certificate (students are required to enrol for The Turkish Preparatory Course if they do not hold a Turkish Proficiency Certificate. Students who cannot obtain a Turkish Proficiency Certificate with C1 level within two years cannot proceed with their master/PhD degree programmes and their registrations are cancelled by the relevant institute.)

Documents for the applications must be in both Turkish and English.

Applications with missing information and/or documents will be cancelled.

The documents uploaded for online registration will be asked by the registration officers for the final registration.

Each candidate can only make one application and they can choose a maximum of two departments. If candidates make more than one application, their applications will be cancelled.

Special conditions and explanations for the specific departments are included in the Placement Table and it is suggested for the applicants to carefully examine.

Tuition fee is applied. (2000 TL for both Fall and Spring Semester. 4500 TL for each semester for Business Secondary Education Programme with Thesis)
